Class 2 (Mrs Robinson & Mrs Wilde)- Grace W for always being so kind and respectful.



Class 4 (Miss Sweeney)- Jacob and Elisa for showing great perseverance in last weeks Sports afternoon.


Class 5 (Mr Qureshi)- Imogen and Stanley for perseverance and courage both when playing football and when reading written work out in class.

This week Class 5 have been finding out more about Islam. We learnt that the Ten Commandments are common to Islam, Christianity and Judaism. However, in Islam, the commandment restricting the use of images means that you will usually only find abstract patterns and scripture as decoration in mosques. The children used the computers to design some patterns that they thought might be acceptable for use in a mosque. You can see some of their designs here. They have now found out more about tessellation, pattern and symmetry in mathematics and art.



Finally, in computing the children used another program to explore symmetry further and consider how some special effects may be created and

used for films and images.


