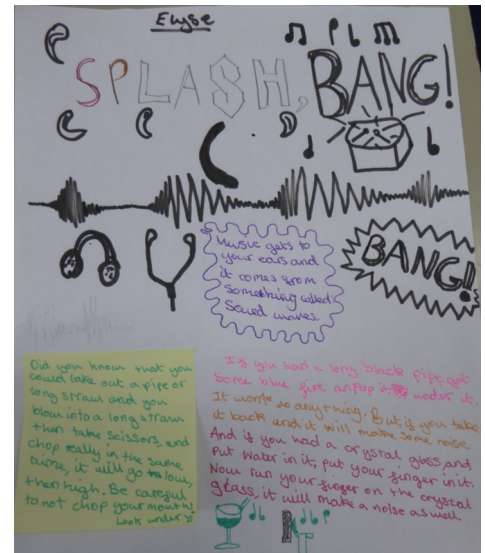

One of the examples here is a pitch variation experiment where a Y4 Chevening pupil was trusted to quickly snip away at the demonstrator's musical instrument while she was playing it!
