Message from Miss Oriel

I wanted to say an absolutely HUGE thank you to all of you who came along to listen to me speak and who gave so generously to support the work we are doing with refugees in Kent. The charities I volunteer with are Tunbridge Wells Welcomes Refugees, for which I will be a trustee, and Kent Kindness Maidstone. I also work closely with Kent Kindness and Meeting Need, but these two groups are currently well-funded so we are going to split the money between Tunbridge Wells Welcomes Refugees and Kent Kindness Maidstone, where it can be used directly for the unaccompanied boys we help.

At Kent Kindness Maidstone, we can put the money towards a group camping trip. Group trips are so important and the boys love these, but they can be difficult to fund for such large numbers! At Tunbridge Wells Welcomes Refugees, we will use the money to provide the extra support needed for one of our most vulnerable boys. Already we have been able to take him out on two day-trips which were an absolute joy to experience. We will be able to take him to the cinema, which he loves, and pay for him to visit his church in London, which means more to him than I can put into words. We will also be able to buy some individual teaching books and organise a couple of day trips further afield. This support is massive to these small charities and any future funding will be warmly welcome.
