Car parking

I am afraid that once again I need to write about car parking at drop off and pick up. Drivers are continuing to ignore our request NOT to use the school drive and car park. As we feared, last Thursday there was a vehicle only accident on the drive; a car which should not have been on school property reversed into a parked car which did have permission to be on the drive. We are only grateful that no children were involved in this incident.

ALSO it has been brought to our attention that drivers are using local resident's drives to not only turn round in, but to stop and drop their children, before reversing out. This is not appropriate and we will be making every effort to identify and contact drivers who are doing this.

We have a small number of parents who, for one reason or another, have special dispensation to park on the school property. We are currently reviewing this list, as we need to reduce congestion in the parking area. If feel that your reason is still valid, please come to the school office as we are now be issuing permits – please be willing to explain your circumstances so a fair decision can be made. We are no longer able to routinely provide parking for all childminders; they will only have access to the car park on days when they have four or more children. If parking is permitted because of parental mobility issues, please only use this when the person concerned is walking from the vehicle to collect children themselves. Requests will be considered on a case by case basis.

From Thursday 25th May, governors have agreed to be on duty on the school gates, due to the high level of their concern for children's safety. Only those with a parking permit will be permitted to park on school premises. I appreciate that parking is difficult. Please arrive earlier, parking with care and walking to school, to ensure the safety of all our children.

Each class chose a book character which they then incorporated in to a mural under the direction of Mrs Sue Salter. The original mural is hung in Class R, but a copy has been transferred onto an acrylic weather proof material and is now in situ on the Library wall by the Library ramp.
