<p style="text-align: center;">Ancient Greek Sports</p> <p>The Olympics committee have asked you to create a new Olympic sport. Explain the rules of this new sport. Include diagrams to help your explanation, or even photos of you partaking in this new sporting event! <i>(Which of our Christian values do you think athletes show when training and participating in sporting events and competitions?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Ancient Greek Comic Strip</p> <p>Turn a myth into a comic strip. For example, Theseus and the Minotaur. Look at comics such as 'The Beano' to remind you of the features to include. <i>(Have you managed to reflect any of our Christian values in this story?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Greek Holiday Planning!</p> <p>How far is it from England to Greece? Research a travel route from England to Greece. How much will it cost for your family to travel to Greece, by any route apart from flying? Think about travel, food, accommodation, etc. <i>(Which of our Christian values did you show when embarking on this challenge?)</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Ancient Greek Computing</p> <p>Create a PowerPoint presentation about any Ancient Greek topic that interests you. Be prepared to share it with the class. <i>(Does your presentation reflect or link to our school vision?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Greek Mythology</p> <p>Write your own version of a Greek Myth. Include illustrations if you like. <i>(Which values and qualities do you think your Ancient Greek gods have shown?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Ancient Greek Timeline</p> <p>Make a timeline of key events from the Ancient Greek period. Think carefully about ordering numbers and positioning them on a number line. Try to include at least 7 key events. <i>(Do you think that any of these events reflect or link to our school vision?)</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Greek Cuisine</p> <p>Visit a Greek restaurant. Look at the menu. How it is different to traditional English food? OR, can you research Greek food online? Maybe you could have a go at making an item of Greek food. <i>(Which of our Christian values do you think cooks and those providing our food produce have to show?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Greek Newspaper Article</p> <p>Write a newspaper report about the Battle of Marathon. Set your work out like a real newspaper. <i>(Which of our Christian values do you think the soldiers going into battle would have demonstrated?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Ancient Greeks Great Thinkers</p> <p>There were many famous Greek scientists, mathematicians and philosophers, including Euclid and Archimedes. Choose one of these great thinkers and create an information page about their life and discoveries. <i>(Did the person you researched show our Christian values or reflect our school vision through their work?)</i></p>

Choose one of the activities from the grid to complete (this may take a couple of weeks).

Once it is finished, bring this into school to share. Make sure you choose at least one from each different colour.
