Find the total cost of your rocket. <i>Either bring in your creation or share it via photos, video or in the form of a poster.</i> <i>(Does your creation reflect or link to our school vision?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Planet Poetry</p> <p>Write an acrostic poem for a planet of your choice. Research the planet to make sure the words and phrases you choose describe the planet. <i>(Have you managed to reflect any of our Christian values in this poem?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Plastic Agents!</p> <p>Over the course of a week (or couple), tally up (and photograph if you can) all the different companies that produce single-use plastic, found in and around your home. Record this first in a table and then present it in the form of a graph of choice. <i>(Which of our Christian values did you show when undertaking this research?)</i></p>

Think carefully about the skills required. <i>(Are you able to make sure the person you look to recruit encompasses both our same values and vision?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Extraterrestrial Instructions</p> <p>Write a set of instructions telling an alien how to pretend to be human and not get caught during a day at school. <i>(Which values and qualities do you think the alien would have to show when embarking on this challenge?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Moon Diary</p> <p>Create a moon diary. Look at the moon every night for at least 4 days in a row, draw what it looks like each night. How does it change? <i>(Which of our Christian values were you encouraged to show whilst completing this?)</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Planet Poster</p> <p>Create a poster showing the names and relative sizes of the planets in the solar system. Add extra facts too if you like! <i>(In what ways does the creation of your poster reflect or link to our school vision?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Space Adventure Story</p> <p>Write a space adventure theme story. Remember to make your story exciting! Include illustrations too, if you like. <i>(In what ways might your adventure story reflect or link to our school vision?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Famous Astronauts</p> <p>Research and create a fact file about a famous astronaut of your choice (male, female or even an animal). <i>(Do you think that any of our Christian values or school vision have been shown or reflected when on their journey to space?)</i></p>
