How might that link to our vision?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Space Report</p> <p>Report on some Space Exploration Achievements from 'The Space Race'. <i>(Which Christian value do people need when trying to achieve things that are challenging and may not work first time?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Space Bases Research and Design</p> <p>Design a Mars Base or Moon Base. It could be a model, picture, diagram, written description... <i>(Which Christian values would people need to show if living together far from the Earth?)</i></p>

It could be a model, picture, drama or even cake! <i>(Which feeling may come from people being amazed by the wonders of the Universe?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">The Diary Entry of an Astronaut</p> <p>Write a diary entry as if you are an astronaut (either alone or with a team). <i>(Which value do you need, in order to be able to tackle a dangerous task?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Space Diet</p> <p>Design, make or explain how you could make nutritional food for someone travelling in space. <i>(It is important to care for people's physical requirements but what else should we consider?)</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Space Game</p> <p>Use your 'Game Skills' to design a game to do with space. It could be a board game, a PE game, a verbal game, computer game... <i>(If a disagreement happens during a game, which value do people need to show next?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Space Tourism Text</p> <p>Write a persuasive text about whether you think 'Space Tourism' is a good idea. <i>(Even though we may have differing opinions, which value should we show when debating?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">It's up to you...</p> <p>Your chance to come up with your own idea of anything you would like to share with us about space! <i>(Which value is needed to ensure we do not offend others?)</i></p>
