6. Freddie's supper club at the school - Laura to discuss with Freddie - How many can be catered for, what would the cost be. Date to be a Friday in April tbc.
7. Smaller events ie playground stalls to be held across the year, dates tbc.

9. Call for meeting to approve costs - Date agreed 4th March 8pm. Need approval of cost to update the school server. PTFA's share of this cost would be 7.5k . The work needs to be done over the Easter break. Agenda to be circulated 1 week prior.
10. Discussed the possibility of external funding for the above server. Perhaps the charitable trust that helped fund the new kitchen. The trust was formed when Combe Bank became Radnor and the funds are just for local organisations, they have struggled to spend them all in previous years so worth a try. Noted that Mrs McLean has already approached Tesco about a separate project.
11. Positions to fill - Chair, Treasurer, and Secretary needed for the next school year with hand overs from June/ July. Reach out to classes regarding this.
12. New role - Legal/Compliance Volunteer. Reach out to classes to hopefully find a parent with relevant experience but if no one is forthcoming we discussed paying a professional for this. We shall but a request in the Newsletter ans discuss in the March meeting.
