## PARENTS/ CARERS

To help our child we will do our best to:

**Provide a quiet workspace** for homework and support our child with the homework set.

**Encourage careful selection** of game, social and film media, to ensure it is appropriate for our child's age.

**Work closely with the School** by attending parent consultations and providing information about any factors, including medical information, which may affect our child's work, welfare or behaviour.

**Encourage our child to live healthily** by eating well, exercising and sticking to a sensible bedtime.

**Ensure our child wears clean, smart and correct school uniform** at all times.

*Support the School's approach to managing emergencies by responding to and following messages, information and requests and explaining information and approaches to our child, so they understand and comply.*
