<p style="text-align: center;">Olympic Sports</p> <p>The Olympics committee have asked you to create a new Olympic sport. Explain the rules of this new sport. Include diagrams to help your explanation, or even photos of you partaking in this new sporting event! <i>(Which of our Christian values do you think athletes need to show in sporting events so that competitions are fair?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Ancient Greek Comic Strip</p> <p>Turn a myth into a comic strip. For example, Theseus and the Minotaur. Look at comics such as 'The Beano' to remind you of the features to include. <i>(Greek Heroes often have to show certain Christian values. What might they be?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Greek Holiday Planning!</p> <p>How far is it from England to Greece? Research a travel route from England to Greece. How much will it cost for your family to travel to Greece, by any route apart from flying? Think about travel, food, accommodation, etc. <i>(Which of our Christian values would you need to demonstrate when visiting the location?)</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>Create a PowerPoint presentation about any Ancient Greek topic that interests you. Be prepared to share it with the class. <i>(Does your presentation reflect or link to our school vision in any way?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Greek Mythology</p> <p>Write your own version of a Greek Myth. Include illustrations to bring it to life! There is often a lesson learnt after mistakes have been made. <i>(Which value do you think people may need to show after a lesson has been learnt?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Performance Poetry to impress Homer!</p> <p>Find a poem that you think will really engage the listeners. How well can you perform it to the class? Can you learn it by heart? <i>(Which values are needed to do this?)</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Food Technology - Greek Cuisine</p> <p>Visit a Greek restaurant. Look at the menu. How it is different to traditional English food? OR, can you research Greek food online? Maybe you could have a go at making an item of Greek food. <i>(If you took care to make sure that no-one was allergic to the food, which value would you be demonstrating?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Greek Architecture</p> <p>Produce drawings or make a model of a piece of an Ancient Greek building; OR an existing modern building that makes use of Ancient Greek features. <i>(If an architect is inspired to copy or make use of an Ancient Greek feature, which value might they show?)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Ancient Greeks Great Thinkers</p> <p>There were many famous Greek scientists, mathematicians and philosophers, including Euclid and Archimedes. Choose one of these great thinkers and create an information page about their life and discoveries. <i>(Did the person you researched show our Christian values or reflect our school vision through their work?)</i></p>

Choose one of the activities from the grid to complete (this may take a couple of weeks).

Once it is finished, bring this into school to share. Make sure you choose at least one from each different colour.
