Building Independence (For these you could email photos of you completing the task or provide a written account of what you did and what you learnt from doing it)	Creative Curriculum Activities	Safety and Skills
Learn how to put away your clothes. You will need to decide where they need to go and make sure they fit/go in those spaces. Some might need to go on hangers. You could even practice folding!	Keep a food diary for a week! Record everything you eat, as this will come in very useful in our Science lessons.	Make a sandwich. Choose your bread or bun, add a spread or butter, and some fillings too. Make sure it's both healthy and delicious!
Learn how to vacuum. With adult supervision, vacuum 2 rooms. Make sure you do the edges. You might even want to try using different nozzles.	Create an animal shelter. Pack your own school bag. Make sure you include your water bottle and coat. On a PE day you will need trainers too.	London Art Piece Choose somewhere or something found in London to draw or paint. Bring it in to share with the class.	Plan which clothes to wear on the weekend. Make sure you look at the weather and think about your activities.
